The King's Guards Trails

Ar y daith hon sy'n hygyrch i bawb, gallwch weld y ffynidwydd Douglas ysblennydd, coed mwyaf Coed y Brenin.

Mwynhewch y llwybr gwastad hwn i'r teulu cyfan ar hyd glan yr afon i weld coed mwyaf y goedwig. Dilynwch yr arwyddbyst ar hyd glan afon Mawddach o'r maes parcio, ar draws porfa'r ardal bicnic ac i ganol y ffynidwydd Douglas enfawr. Oddi yno, gallwch gerdded at 'Bencampwr y Brenin', y goeden dalaf ac ymwlod â'r maen coffa. HIGHLIGHTS

See the magnificent Douglas firs, the biggest trees in Coed y Brenin, on this walk accessible to all.


Enjoy this level family-riverside-walk to the biggest trees in the forest. Follow the waymarkers alongside the river Mawddach from the car park, across the grassy picnic site, and into the heart of the giant Douglas firs. You can walk to the 'King', the tree with the widest trunk, and the 'King's Champion', the tallest tree, and visit the commemorative stone. Disgrifiad: Mae'r **Llwybr Marchogion y Brenin 5a** hygrych ag arwyddbyst glas yn gylchdaith fer sy'n arwain at y 'Brenin' ac yna'n dychwelyd i'r maes parcio. Dyma lwybr 2m o led ag arwyneb da sy'n addas ar gyfer cadeiriau olwyn. Ceir mannau gorffwys o leiaf bob 100m.

Mae'r arwyddbyst melyn yn mynd ymlaen at **Llwybr Pencampwr y Brenin 5b** ar llethr ychydig yn fwy serth ac yn dod i lawr yn ôl i'r maes parcio ar hyd ffordd darmac â llethr o 20%/1 mewn 5. Mae'r rhan yma yn addas i gadeiriau gwthio plant ac nid oes grisiau na chamfeydd ar hyd yr holl lwybr.

Description: The blue-waymarked accessible **5a King's Guards Trail** is a short loop path which leads to the 'King' and then returns to the car park. It is a well-surfaced 2m-wide route and is suitable for wheelchairs. There are resting points at least every 100m.

The yellow waymarkers lead on to the **5b King's Champion Trail** on a slightly steeper gradient and descend back to the car park on a tarmac road with a slope of 20%/1 in 5. This section is suitable for pushchairs and there are no steps or stiles along the whole trail.
