UCHAFBWYNTIAU

Gadewch brysurdeb Betws-y-coed i ddarganfod llyn llonydd a phrydferth.

Dilynwch yr arwyddbyst gwyn i fyny ffordd serth drwy'r goedwig o Eglwys y Santes Fair yn syth i Llyn Elsi.

Yn ystod yr Ail Ryfel Byd, byddai faciwis i'r ardal hon yn nofio draw i'r ynysoedd i gasglu wyau'r gwyllanod a oedd yn nythu yno gan fod angen bwyd arnyn nhw oherwydd y dogni!

Dilynwch y llwybr o amgylch y llyn wrth iddo agosáu ac ymbellhau o ymyl y dŵr nes i chi ymuno â'r prif llwybr i olrhain eich camau yn ôl i Fetws-y-Coed.

HIGHLIGHTS

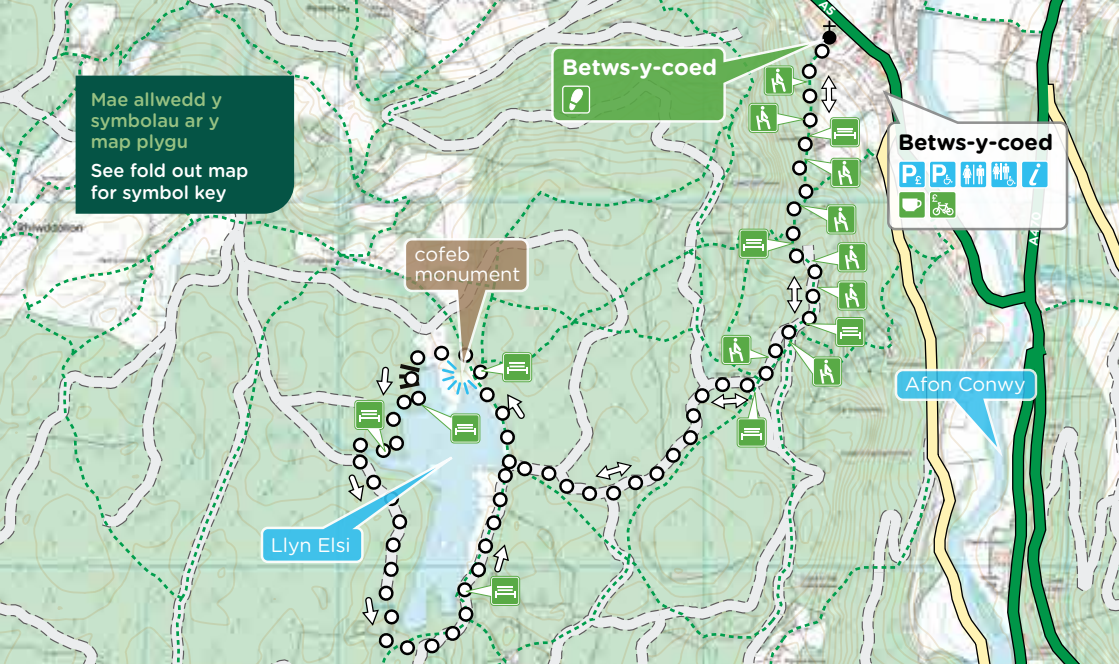
Leave the bustle of Betws-y-coed to discover a tranquil and scenic lake.

Follow the white waymarkers steeply up a forest road from St Mary's church, directly to Llyn Elsi.

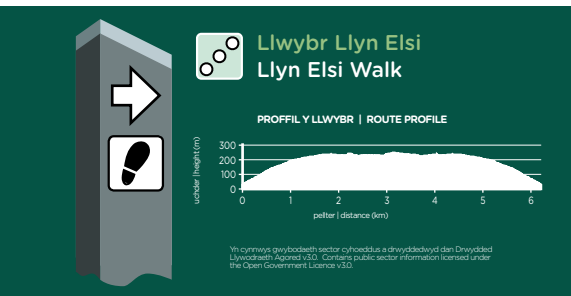
During World War II, evacuees to this area would swim across to the islands to gather the eggs of the gulls that nest there as extra rations!

Follow the path around the lake as it cuts in and out from the water's edge until you join the main path to re-trace your steps back to Betws-y-coed.

Dechrau: Betws-y-coed, y tu ôl i eglwys y Santes Fair

Gradd: Anodd

Amser: 2-3 awr

Pellter: 3.9 milltir | 6.2km

Dringo: 1043tr | 318m

Disgrifiad: Mae'r llwybr yn dringo'n serth iawn o Fetws-y-coed gan ddilyn ffyrdd y goedwig a llwybrau troed culach, llai nag 1m o led mewn rhai manau, ar arwyneb garw ac anwastad lle bydd mwd, cerrig a gwreiddiau coed dan draed. Mae meinciau niferus a manau gorffwys ar y ddringfa serth o'r pentref a sawl mainc o amgylch y llyn.

Follow the white waymarker symbols

Start: Betws-y-coed, behind St Mary's church

Grade: Strenuous

Time: 2-3 hours

Distance: 3.9 miles | 6.2km

Climb: 1043ft | 318m

Description: The trail climbs very steeply from Betws-y-coed following forest roads and narrower footpaths, less than 1m wide in some places, on an unmade and uneven surface, where you can expect mud, rocks and tree roots. There are numerous benches and resting posts on the steep climb from the village and several benches around the lake.
