A lack of understanding on the dynamics of marine litter and the potential cost of monitoring means that targets for marine litter reduction cannot be set and measured against with confidence at present. A significant amount of marine litter is sourced outside the Welsh national boundary due to prevailing winds onto beaches and the presence of some litter 'sinks'. Greater consideration of how reducing marine litter on a regional scale is therefore very important and also research on transport pathways and accumulation at litter sinks would be welcomed. The MSFD initial assessment showed that there are some problems associated with marine litter in the Celtic Seas region and negative impacts of marine litter have been observed in Wales Marine Protected Areas. Litter is considered a issue in almost all SACs and is considered a threat in a number of areas particularly in North Cardigan Bay. In some SACs marine litter is contributing to unfavourable condition.
