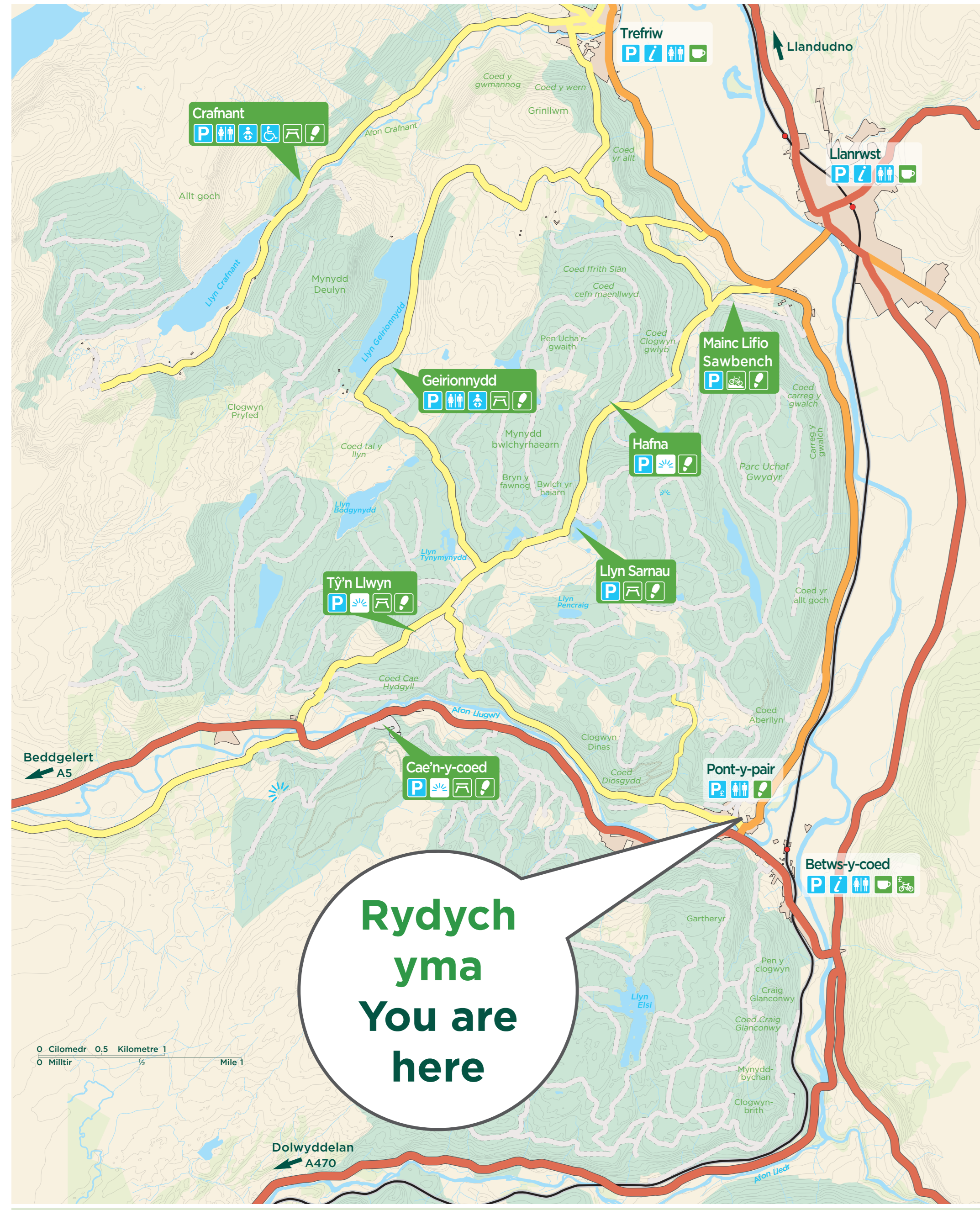




Parc Coedwig Gwydyr Forest Park

The beautiful and secluded Llyn Parc, mining history and good views.
DESCRIPTION: The walk mainly follows wide forest roads but there are sections of forest path that are both narrow and steep.

DISGRIFIAD: Cylchdaith gyda llwybrau cul a garw mewn rhai manau, rhwng creigiau mawr a gwreiddiau coed. Mae sawl clogwyn serth ar hyd y llwybr, felly gofal piau hi, ac mae'n codi a disgyn yn serth mewn rhai manau.

HIGHLIGHTS:
A great work-out for your legs and your lungs!

DESCRIPTION: This path is narrow and rough in sections, with large rocks and tree roots. There are a number of cliff edges, so care is required and it rises and descends steeply in places.

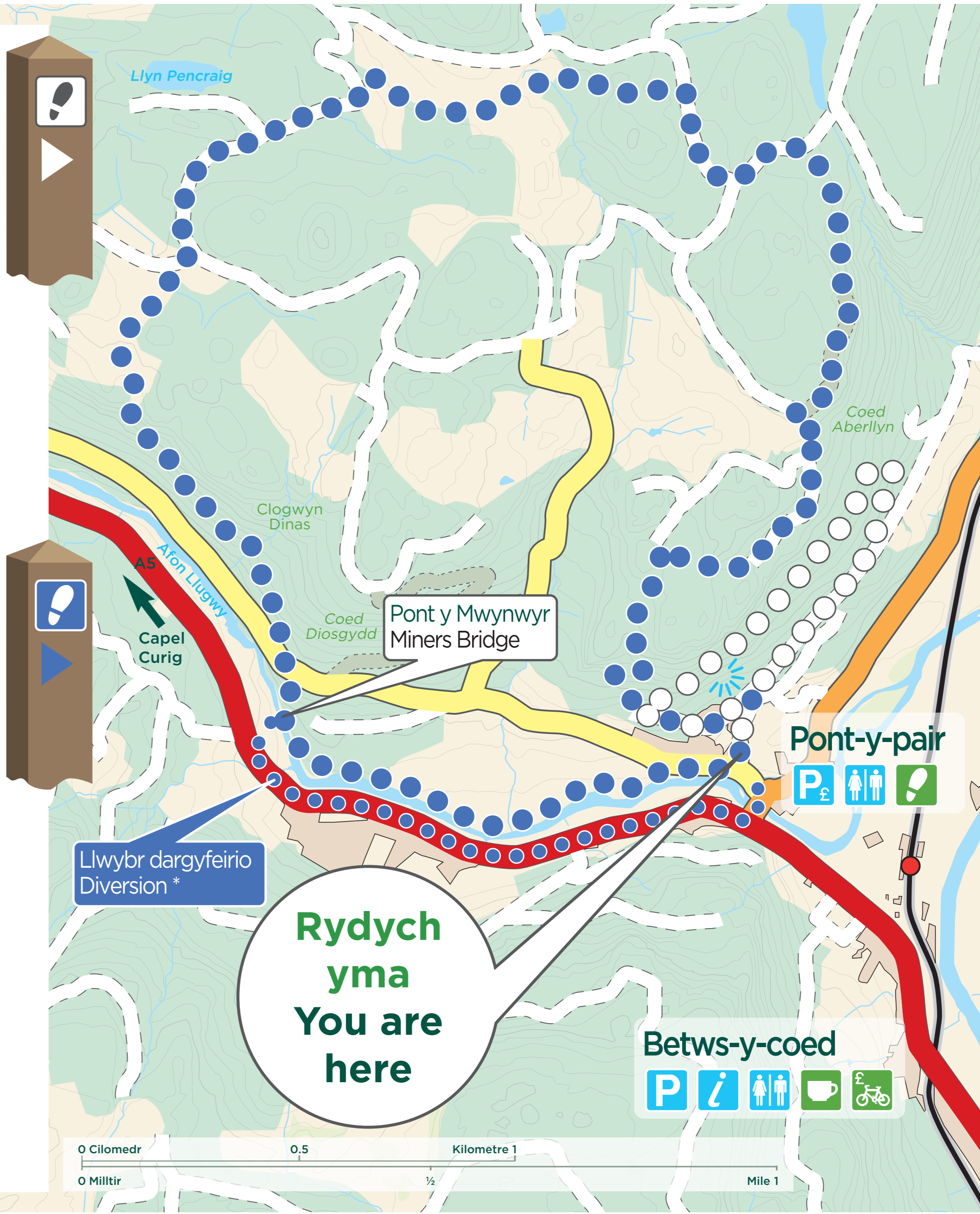
UCHAFBWYNTIAU:
Diwedd trawiadol ar lan Afon Llugwy.
DISGRIFIAD: Mae'r amodau cerdded mor amrywiol â'r dirwedd, o ffordd goedwig a llwybrau mwdlyd i eltydd creigiog a llwybrau glan yr afon â gwreiddiau coed - ond mae'n werth y drafferth! Mae nifer o gamfeydd ar y llwybr. Byddwch yn ofalus yn y darn islaw Diosgydd Uchaf, sy'n gallu bod yn wlyb a lliethrig weithiau.

HIGHLIGHTS:
A spectacular finish along the River Llugwy.

DESCRIPTION: The variety of landscape is matched by the variety of walking conditions, from forest road and mud paths to narrow and steep rocky sections and on to riverside paths with exposed tree roots - well worth the effort! There are a number of stiles on the route. Care should be taken on the section below Diosgydd Uchaf as this can be wet and slippery at times.

***Ar ôl cawod drom o law, gall yr Afon Llugwy orlifo'i glannau ar ran o'r llwybr sy'n dilyn yr afon yn ôl i Fetws y Coed. Mewn amodau o'r fath dilynwch y llwybr dargyfeirio.**

***If there has been a lot of rain, the Afon Llugwy may flood across the section of the path that follows the river back into Betws y Coed. Follow the diversion under such conditions.**

Croeso i Bont-y-pair Dyma gartref y cewri!

Fe blannwyd y ffynidwydd Douglas anferth o amgylch Betws-y-coed yn goed fainc yn y 1920au a bellach maent yn pwyso dros 10 tunnell yr un.

Fedrwyd gerddeu o'r fan yma i edrych ar y coed enfawr ysblynydd ar eu gorau drwy ddilyn y llwybr troed a'r llwybrau estyllod rhydd ar hyn glannau Llugwy. Fe gafodd y llwybr ei greu drwy bartneriaeth rhwng Comisiwn Coedwigaeth Cymru a'r Cyngor Cymuned.

Mae yna 3 o lwybrau dynodedig sy'n cychwyn o'r ochr yma i'r dref ac yn eich arwain drwy'r llechweddau coediog, heibio i fwyngloddiau, llynoedd, dolydd, clogwyni a nentydd. Defnyddiwch y llwybrau i'ch helpu i archwilio'r dirwedd hynafol ac amrywiol hon.

Welcome to Pont-y-pair This is the home of the giants!

The giant Douglas fir trees around Betws-y-coed were planted as saplings in the 1920s and now weigh over 10 tonnes each.

You can walk from here to see these splendid giants at their best by following the easy graded boardwalk and footpath along the banks of the Llugwy. Natural Resources Wales and the Community Council created this path in partnership.

Three Natural Resources Wales waymarked trails start from this end of the town and take you up through forested hillsides, past mines, lakes, meadows, cliffs and streams. Use these trails to explore this ancient and varied landscape.
