
Pont y Pair

Animal Puzzle Trail

// A woodland trail for budding detectives







Clues

Follow the clues and the map around the red trail keeping your eyes peeled for the animals.

- 1 I croak in the night and have cold green skin, I like damp places to spend my time in!
- 2 Deep in the forest I hunt and I bark, a bit like a dog but I am out in the dark!
- 3 Knock, Knock, I am a bird who uses my beak to dig out insect grubs in dead trees.
- 4 I am not a zebra but I am black and white, I live in a sett and eat slugs and grubs at night!
- 5 I sleep upside down, I am incredibly light, hunting by sound and flying by night!
- 6 Bright eyed and bushy tailed, I scamper on the forest floor, collecting nuts and cones for my winter store!
- 7 Twit-twoo, a tree is my house, I eat little creatures, I like a tasty mouse!
- 8 On long summer days, you will see me flutter, with my long tongue I feed on nectar!
- 9 I am a mammal, eat insects, my body is round and I have a short tail and a pointed snout. I have a spiky coat, and when frightened I roll myself up in a ball.
- 10 I am a shy furry mammal and live in a holt by the river. I eat fish and like to play in water.
- 11) I live in the sea but return to the stream I was born in to lay my eggs by swimming and leaping upstream.
- 12 Look for me near water. I get my name because I bob up and down and dive in the river looking for insects. I have waterproof feathers!
