




Pam ydyn ni'n chwistrellu coed?

Why are we injecting trees?

The trees you can see with holes and marks on the trunk have been infected with the fungal-like disease **Phytophthora ramorum**.

To stop the disease spreading we have had to kill them quickly by injecting the stems with a herbicide (it doesn't affect humans or animals).

A legal notice has been issued to us to treat these trees. Eventually we will cut them down, remove them and re-plant the area.
