### Introductory note

#### This introductory note does not form a part of the notice.

The following notice gives notice of the variation and consolidation of an environmental permit.

This variation incorporates the changes required by the Industrial Emissions Directive following a statutory review of permits in the cement, lime and magnesium oxide sector. These include the amendment of the wording of several permit conditions relating to notifications, changes to emission limits and monitoring requirements and also includes the addition of a condition relating to a requirement for monitoring of groundwater and soil. The interpretation section of the permit has also been updated and the opportunity has been taken to consolidate the original permit and subsequent variations.

The Industrial Emissions Directive (IED) came into force on 7 January 2014 with the requirement to implement all relevant Best Available Techniques (BAT) conclusions as described in the Commission Implementing Decision. The BAT conclusions for production of cement, lime and magnesium oxide were published on 9 April 2013 in the Official Journal of the European Union (L100) following a European Union wide review of BAT, implementing decision 2013/163/EU of 26 March 2013. We are satisfied that the operator will be compliant with the published BAT conclusions which will apply from 9 April 2017.

This variation also includes updated conditions relating to Chapter IV of the Industrial Emissions Directive relating to the co-incineration of waste. These changes replace references to the Waste Incineration Directive (WID).

The schedules specify the changes made to the permit. Schedule 1 of the notice specifies the conditions that have been varied and schedule 2 comprises a consolidated permit which reflects the changes being made.
