Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice.

The following notice gives notice of the variation and consolidation of an environmental permit.

This variation incorporates the changes required by the Industrial Emissions Directive following a statutory review of permits in the production of pulp, paper and board sector. This includes the amendment of the wording of several permit conditions relating to notifications and also includes the addition of a condition relating to a requirement for monitoring of groundwater and soil. The opportunity has also been taken to consolidate the original permit and subsequent variations.

The Industrial Emissions Directive (IED) came into force on 7th January 2014 with the requirement to implement all relevant Best Available Techniques (BAT) conclusions as described in the Commission Implementing Decision. The BAT conclusions for production of pulp, paper and board were published on 30 September 2014 in the Official Journal of the European Union (L284) following a European Union wide review of BAT, implementing decision 2014/687/EU of 26 September 2014. We are satisfied that the operator is already compliant with the published BAT conclusions which will apply from 30th September 2018.

This variation also includes updated conditions relating to Chapter IV of the Industrial Emissions Directive relating to the incineration of waste. These replace references to the Waste Incineration Directive (WID), but do not alter any emission limits or permit requirements.

The Installation is no longer subject to the Large Combustion Plant Directive and conditions relating to this have been removed.

The schedules specify the changes made to the permit. Schedule 1 of the notice specifies the conditions that have been varied and schedule 2 comprises a consolidated permit which reflects the changes being made.

The status log of a permit sets out the permitting history, including any changes to the permit reference number.
