

Welcome to Hafren Forest and the Source of the River Severn

The forest takes its name from Afon Hafren (River Severn) which begins quietly in a squelchy peat bog on Pumlumon, Mid Wales' highest mountain. In no time at all it becomes a torrent with falls and cascades plunging headlong through the forest. Enjoy this beautiful river on our waymarked forest walks.

Enjoy your visit - Take Care

- Wear strong walking shoes or boots.
- Always carry windproofs and a warm sweater if you are going onto high ground and waterproofs in unsettled weather.
- This is a working forest so please keep well clear of forest operations and obey all signs that you encounter.

Y Llwybr

Mae llwybr cylchog i Darddiad Afon Hafren sy'n rhan ddechreuo o Lwybr Afon Hafren, sef llwybr hiraf Prydain ar hyd afon - 210 milltir.

Mantais arall y llwybr yw fod Llwybr Bro Gwy yn dechrau yn y maes parcio hefyd, gan fynd allan o'r goedwig a heibio i Darddiad Afon Gwy, sydd hefyd ar Bumlumon. Gall cerddwyr brwd ddilyn y llwybr yr holl ffordd i Gas-gwent. Mae llwybrau eraill, llawer byrrach, ar gael ar gyfer pob lefel o allu. Mae amrywiaeth trawiadol o adar yn y goedwig, yn eu plith y mae'r Trochwr (sy'n bwydo yn yr afon), y Barcud Coch urddasol ac fe welwch y Gosog swil os ydych chi'n lwcus.

- Llwybr Pob-gallu Rhaeadrau - $\frac{1}{2}$ milltir
- Llwybr Tarddiad Hafren - 7 milltir - gyda Changen i Ben Pumlumon Arwystli (741m) - 3 milltir ychwanegol
- Llwybr Rhaeadr Blaen Hafren - 3 milltir
- Llwybr Hafren-Torri-Gwddf - $1\frac{1}{2}$ milltir
- Safleoedd picnic mewn dolydd ac ar lannau'r afon
- Toiledau - Pasg-mis Hydref

The walks

The outward leg of the Source of the Severn trail forms the beginning of the Severn Way, Britain's longest riverside walk at 210 miles.

The Wye Valley walk starts from this car park and heads out of the forest past the source of the Wye, which also lies on Pumplumon. Ambitious walkers can follow the route all the way to Chepstow. Other much shorter walks cater for all abilities. Keep an eye out for Hafren's wide range of birdlife including the river feeding dipper, the red kite and if you are very lucky, the elusive Goshawk.

What's on offer

- All-ability Cascades Walk – ½ mile
- Source of the Severn Trail – 7 miles
 - with Spur to Pen Pumplumon Arwystli (741m) – 3 miles extra
- Blaen Hafren Falls Trail – 3 miles
- Severn Breaks-its-Neck Trail – 1½ miles
- Meadow and riverside picnic sites
- Toilets – Easter-October


A shady zig-zag path leads you down to an all ability boardwalk. This takes you along the River Severn to the tumbling Cascades.






