This is a strenuous circular walk, where you will climb over the Cefndeuddwr ridge before descending via a stone bridge to the Gwynfynydd goldmine and waterfalls.

**Gradd:** Anodd  
**Amser:** 2 awr  
**Pellter:** 4½ milltir/7km  
**Dringo:** 230m

**Disgrifiad:** Mae'r llwybr yn dilyn cyfuniad o ffyrdd y goedwig a llwybrau culion, serth, llai nag 50cm o led mewn manau, ar arwyneb garw, anwastad, ble gallwch ddisgwyl gweld mwd, creigiau a gwreiddiau coed. Wrth ddisgwyl i fwynglawdd Gwynfynydd, mae gan y llwybr gerrig rhydd dan draed, sylwch ar y postyn gwybodaeth cyn cyrraedd yr adran hon. Argymhellir gwisgo esgidiau cadarn. Anaddas ar gyfer bygis ag olwynion.

## Follow the red waymarker symbols.

**Start:** Visitor Centre  
**Grade:** Strenuous  
**Time:** 2 hours  
**Distance:** 4½ miles/7km  
**Climb:** 230m

**Description:** The trail is on a combination of forest roads and steep narrow paths, often less than 50cm wide in places, on an unmade, uneven surface, where you can expect mud, rocks and tree roots. On your decent to the Gwynfynydd goldmine the trail has loose stones underfoot, notice the information post before reaching this section. Stout footwear recommended. Not suitable for wheeled buggies.
