Mae'r llwybr yn dringo'n raddol drwy'r pentref ac i fyny ffordd goedwig, a'r Cwm yn agor o'ch blaenau. Wrth y bont, edmygwch y golygfeydd o Garreg Alltrem arw, sy'n boblogaidd ymhlith dringwyr.

Rydych yn dychwelyd i Ddolwyddelan ar hyd ffordd Rufeinig Sarn Helen, a aeth o'r gogledd i'r de drwy Gymru, a heibio panel dehongli yn Nhau Penamnen sy'n adrodd hanes cymuned sydd wedi hen ddiiflannu. Dychwelwch i'r pentref ar hyd y ffordd darmac.


HIGHLIGHTS

Take in a great view of the head of the valley and across to Moel Siabod.

The trail climbs gradually through the village and up a forest road with the Cwm opening up before you. At the bridge admire the views of the rugged Carreg Alltrem, popular with climbers.

You return to Dolwyddelan along the Sarn Helen Roman road, which ran north to south through Wales, and past an interpretation panel at Tai Penamnen which tells the story of a community which is long gone. Return to the village along the tarmac road.







Dringo: 120m

Disgrifiad: Mae'r llwybr hwn yn bennaf yn dilyn ffordd goedwig lydan a ffordd darmac gul. Mae un darn o lwybr culach ag arwyneb llyfn lle mae'n croesi'r afon ar brenpen. Ger y bont, mae dau wrdd picnic a lle parcio bychan i ddau gar.

Follow the blue waymarker symbols

Start: Dolwyddelan Railway Station car park

Grade: Easy

Time: 1-2 hours

Distance: 1½ miles/2.9km

Climb: 120m

Description: This trail mainly follows a wide forest road and a narrow tarmac road. There is one section of narrower path with a smooth surface where it crosses the river on a footbridge. Near the bridge, there are two picnic tables and a small parking space for two cars.
