Cymerwch i fewn yr olygfa ar draws y llyn i'r clegyrau ym mhen Dyffryn Crafnant a Gwarchodfa Natur Genedlaethol Cwm Glas Crafnant.

Dilynwch y llwybr sy'n dringo'r dyffryn yn raddol; mae'r olygfa wedi'i fframio gan glegyrau a hen fwyngloddiau llechi.

Math prin o goetir onnen yw'r coetir ar y clogwyni serth uwchben. Nid oes llwybrau o gwbl drwy'r warchodfa serth iawn, felly o'r llwybr hwn y ceir ei gweld orau. Dychwelwch i'r maes parcio drwy ddilyn y ffordd darmac.

HIGHLIGHTS

Take in the view across the lake to the crags at the head of the Crafnant Valley and Cwm Glas Crafnant National Nature Reserve.

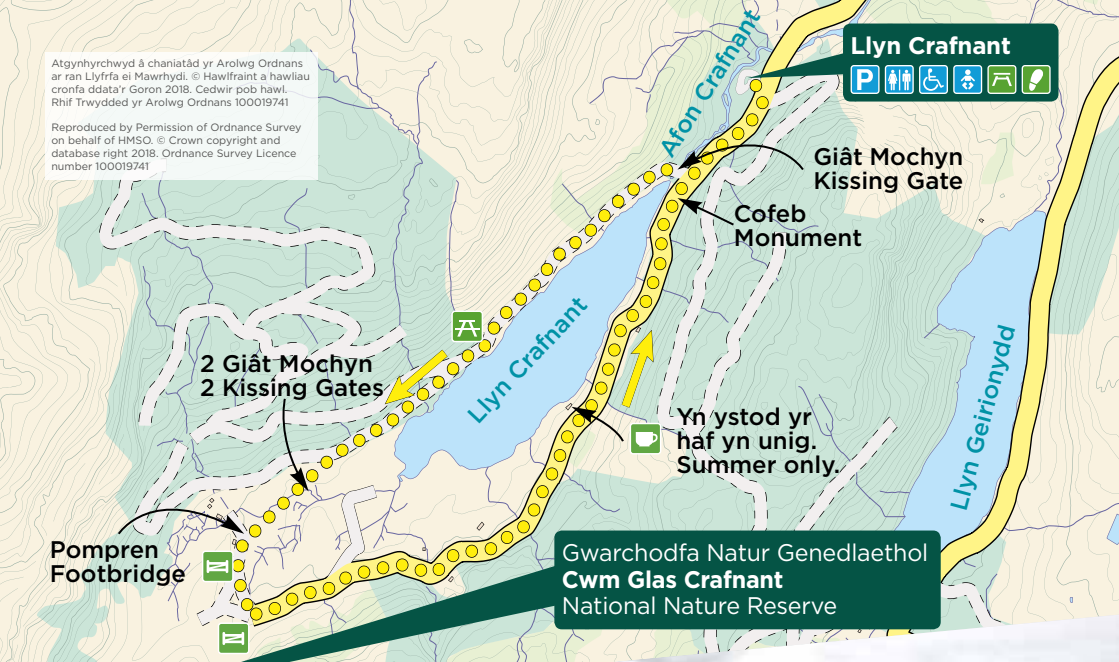
Follow the trail climbing gently up the valley; the view is framed by imposing crags and old slate mines.

The woodland on the steep cliffs above is a rare type of ash woodland. There are no paths through the very steep reserve so it is best viewed from this walk. Return to the car park by following the tarmac road.

Dechrau: Maes parcio Crafnant

Gradd: Hawdd

Amser: 1-2 awr

Pellter: 3 milltir/5km

Dringo: 94m

Disgrifiad: Mae'r llwybr cylchol hwn yn dilyn cymysgedd o lwybrau llydan, ffyrdd tarmac a choedwig, gyda rhai darnau mwy garw wrth ymyl y llyn. Ar hyd y llwybr mae tair giât mochyn a dwy giât.

Follow the yellow waymarker symbols.

Start: Crafnant car park.

Grade: Easy

Time: 1-2 hours

Distance: 3 miles/5km

Climb: 94m

Description: This circular route follows a mixture of wide tracks, tarmac and forest roads, with some rougher sections alongside the lake. Along the route there are three kissing gates and two gates.
