Taith Cyrau Cyrau Walk



UCHAFBWYNTIAU

Troi cefn ar fwrlwm Betws-y-coed ar y daith gerdded hon gyda golygfa drawiadol dros y dref ar ôl dilyn llwybr troellog drwy binwydd Douglas mawreddog.

Er eich bod ymhell uwchlaw'r dref, gallwch glywed ceir yn mynd heibio islaw weithiau. Ddegawdau lawer yn ôl, buasai'r sŵn yn y cefndir yn wahanol iawn: clecian y gwaith o'r mwyngloddiau cyfagos. Roedd mwyngloddio'n ddiwydiant mawr yn yr ardal hon - gallwch weld rhai o'r adfeilion mwyngloddio ar deithiau cerdded eraill yn y pecyn hwn fel Llwybr Mwynwyr Hafna a Llwybr Mwynglawdd Cyffty.

HIGHLIGHTS

Leave the bustle of Betws-y-coed on this walk with a stunning view over the town after taking a winding path through majestic Douglas firs.

Despite being high above the town, you can sometimes hear cars passing below. Many decades ago, the background noise would have been very different: the clatter of work from the surrounding mines. Mining was a big industry in this area - you can experience some of the mining remains on other walks in this pack such as Hafna Miners Trail and Cyffty Mine Trail.

Dechrau: Maes parcio talu ac arddangos a Thoiledau Cyhoeddus Pont y Pair

Gradd: Anodd

Amser: 1½ awr

Pellter: 1½ milltir/2.4km

Dringo: 135m

Disgrifiad: Cylch o llwybr yw hwn ar gyfuniad o ffyrdd coedwig a llwybr troed cul serth, o lai na 50cm o led mewn mannau, sy'n arw ac anwastad dan droed, lle gallwch ddisgwyll mwd, creigiau a gwreiddiau coed. Mae nifer o olygfannau ymyl clogwyn heb eu ffensi, ac arwyddbyst ar eu cyfer. Mae'r llwybr byr hwn yn esgyn a disgyn yn serth mewn mannau, gan olygu bod y daith hon yn ffordd wych o ymarfer eich coesau a'ch ysgyfaint! Nid oes meinciau o gwbl ar y llwybr.

Start: Pont-y-Pair pay and display car park and Public Toilets

Grade: Strenuous

Time: 1½ hours

Distance: 1½ miles/2.4km

Climb: 135m

Description: This is a circular route on a combination of forest roads and a steep narrow footpath, less than 50cm wide in some places, on an unmade and uneven surface, where you can expect mud, rocks and tree roots. There are a number of unfenced cliff edge viewpoints which are signposted. This short trail ascends and descends steeply in places, making this walk a great work-out for your legs and your lungs! There are no benches on the trail.
