Llwybr Rhaeadr Ewynnol Swallow Falls Walk


**Gweld y rhaeadrau ar ôl glaw trwm,
a'r golygfeydd o Foel Siabod a Phedol
yr Wyddfa ar ddiwrnod clir.**

O'r maes parcio, dilynwnch y llwybr sy'n disgyn drwy'r coetir. Daw sŵn yr afon yn uwch wrth ichi agosáu at Rhaeadr Ewynnol. Ymhellach ar hyd y ffordd, mae'r llwybr yn culhau rhwng clogwyn bach a chwmp wedi'i ffensio i lawr i'r afon cyn dechrau dringo'n serth drwy'r goedwig i olygfan arall uwchben y dyffryn, gyda golygfeydd o Foel Siabod ac, ar ddiwrnod clir, Pedol yr Wyddfa. Oddi yma, mae'r llwybr yn dringo'n ysgafn yn ôl i'r maes parcio.

HIGHLIGHTS

**Experiencing the falls after heavy rain,
and the views of Moel Siabod and the
Snowdon Horseshoe on a clear day.**

From the carpark, follow the descending path through the woodland. The sound of the river gets louder as you approach Swallow Falls. Further along, the path narrows between a small cliff and a fenced drop down to the river before starting to climb steeply through the wood to another viewpoint above the valley, with views of Moel Siabod, and in clear weather, the Snowdon Horseshoe. From here, it's a gentle climb back to the carpark.

Dechrau: Maes parcio Tŷ'n Llwyn

Gradd: Anodd

Amser: 2½ awr

Pellter: 2½ milltir/3.8km

Dringo: 170m

Disgrifiad: Llwybr cylchol sy'n dechrau o faes parcio Tŷ'n Llwyn. Mae'r llwybr hwn yn bennaf ar lwybrau cul, garw, serth o lai na 70cm mewn mannau, sy'n arw ac anwastad dan droed, lle gallwch ddisgwyl llaid, creigiau a gwreiddiau coed. Mae nifer o risiau ar y llwybr a mainc wrth y rhaeadr lle gallwch orffwys ac edmygu'r olygfa.



Follow the yellow waymarker symbols

Start: Ty'n Llwyn car park

Grade: Strenuous

Time: 2½ hours

Distance: 2½ miles/3.8km

Climb: 170m

Description: A circular route starting from Ty'n Llwyn car park. This trail is mainly on steep rough narrow paths less than 70cm wide in some places, on unmade and uneven surfaces, where you can expect mud, rocks and tree roots. There are several flights of steps on the trail and a bench at the waterfall where you can rest and admire the view. There is a wheelchair accessible picnic table in the car park.
