Opportunity to plant shade tolerant trees

NRW investigating land ownership and consents for potential planting opportunities

Enhancement opportunity to relocate bench from Tegid Street to provide additional seating

Opportunity to plant small trees / orchard. NRW to consult with landowner

Hedgerow planted along existing fenceline (if woodland copse planting in this area cannot be agreed)

Proposed hedgerow replanting

Proposed small tree and shrub planting

Opportunity for screen planting to deter fly tipping

Fencing of native hedgerow / trees to protect and preserve from damage from grazing

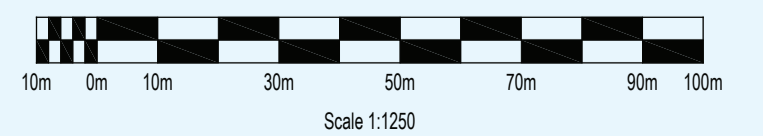
