

# Clues



Follow the clues and the map around the red trail keeping your eyes peeled for the animals.

- 1 I'm related to dogs and sometimes bark but my fur's always red and I hunt after dark.
- 2 Knock, knock, I am a bird who uses my beak to dig out insect grubs in dead trees.
- 3 I am not a zebra but I am striped black and white, I live in a sett and eat slugs and grubs at night!
- 4 I bob up and down on the rocks in the river. I catch insects underwater and have waterproof feathers!
- 5 I return from the sea to the river where I was born, swimming and leaping upstream to spawn.
- 6 I'm a shy furry mammal, living in a holt by the river. I swim and eat fish and play in the water.
- 7 I croak in the night and have cold green skin. I like damp places to spend my time in!
- 8 I sleep upside down, I am incredibly light, hunting by sound and flying by night!
- 9 On long summer days, you will see me flutter, with my long tongue I feed on nectar!
- 10 Brown fur, white bib, I am related to weasels. The size of a cat I hunt birds and small mammals.
- 11 We open pine cones high in conifer trees, using special crossed beaks to get at the seeds.
- 12 I have a spiky coat, eat slugs and I'm small, and when I get frightened I roll up into a ball.
- 13 Twit-twoo, a tree hole is my house, I'll fly out at night to hunt for a mouse!
- 14 I sleep through the winter, have a long tail and squeak! The nut of the hazel is a food that I seek!
- 15 I'm a type of crow but my feathers are pink! I fly through oak woodlands and my call is a screech.
- 16 I eat nuts, bushy tailed, my fur is red not grey. I scamper up trees to my home called a drey.

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
