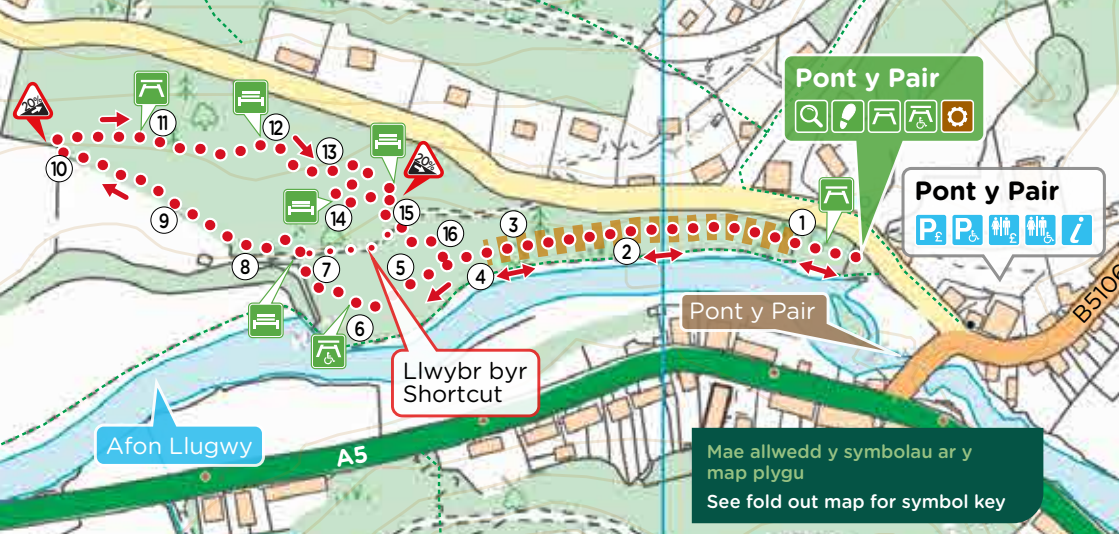

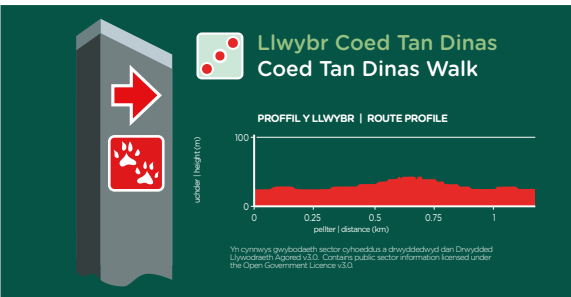
Take this short, easy walk under tall and majestic Douglas fir trees - some are up to 100 years old!

Dechrau: Panel croeso ger toiledau a maes parcio talu ac arddangos Pont y Pair

Gradd: Hawdd

Amser: ½ awr

Pellter: 0.7 milltir | 1.2km

Dringo: 112tr | 34m

Disgrifiad: Mae'r llwybr yn dilyn yr afon ar lwybr pren 1.5m o led, cyn dringo'n raddol drwy'r coed ar lwybr llydan ag iddo arwyneb da. Mae'r llwybr yn addas i gadeiriau gwthio ac mae nifer o feinciau a byrddau picnic ar hyd y daith.

Follow the red waymarker symbols

Start: Welcome panel near to Pont y Pair pay and display car park and toilets

Grade: Easy

Time: ½ hour

Distance: 0.7 miles | 1.2km

Climb: 112ft | 34m

Description: The trail follows the river, on a 1.5m-wide boardwalk, before gradually climbing through the woods on a wide well-surfaced path. The trail is suitable for pushchairs and there are several benches and picnic tables along the route.
